Results of Delhi Assembly Election Survey, 2020

"Developing Countries Research Centre (dcrc) projects an astounding victory for AAP in Delhi Assembly Elections, 2020"

A meticulously planned, scientifically designed and objectively executed psephological research survey conducted by the Developing Countries Research Centre (dcrc), University of Delhi, under the title "dcrc Samiksha: Delhi 2020" projects a landslide victory for AAP in the recently concluded Assembly Elections in Delhi.

These results are based on a sample of 103,731 voters taken from all 70 assembly constituencies of the Capital from 1-6 February 2020.

Parliamentary Constituency-wise Results

The extensive election survey of Delhi Assembly was led by 14 Fellow Coordinators from 7 parliamentary constituencies with the help of approximately 500 Student Surveyors. This is the first and the only survey in India's post-independence electoral history with more than 1 lakh samples, collected from all 70 constituencies and 272 wards, thus making the results viable, reliable and credible.
